Canine Castration

Your dog has just been castrated. There are a few after care instructions you should follow to help the healing process. Try to limit your dog from a lot of physical activity for about one week. Keep the suture area clean and dry. We prefer you to wait two weeks before bathing. You may apply neosporin to the suture area twice a day. This will help alleviate any discomfort, where your dog may chew at the sutures. If by some chance the sutures come out, please call our clinic so we may let you know what to do. You may notice that your dog may have a decrease in appetite and activity for a few days after surgery, but he will be fine after he has healed completely. The sutures will not need to be removed because they are dissolvable. Please call with any questions or concerns you may have at (706) 232-0364.
